

1. Full Travel Registration open and close dates
  - a. Full Travel Registration will open as soon as practicable in March and will close on April 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - b. Players registering after April 30<sup>th</sup> will be placed on waiting list for available roster spots.
  - c. Players need to be paid by April 30<sup>th</sup>. Dates TBD to pay in person at the clubhouse.
  - d. All Player documentation (e.g., birth certificate, etc.) needs to be uploaded to Bonzi by April 30<sup>th</sup>. Parents needing assistance (scanning documents, digital photographs, etc.) can receive assistance during TBD in person pay dates at the clubhouse.
2. Full Travel rosters: Field a Squad (FAS) minimum, Coaches to Carry (CTC) minimum, and Maximum Roster (MR) numbers.
  - a. 7v7 – 9 FAS, 14 CTC, and 14 MR.
  - b. 9v9 – 11 FAS, 16 CTC, and 16 MR.
  - c. 11v11 – FAS 13, 15 CTC (By-Law), and 18 MR.
3. Gender Policies
  - a. Girls can try out for age appropriate boys team if age appropriate girls team unavailable.
  - b. Girls cannot try out for age appropriate boys team if the tryout may result in the displacement of an age appropriate boy when an age appropriate girls team is available or if the tryout results in a violation of the Playing Up policy.
  - c. Transgender players can register for the gender team with which the player identifies, with confirmation or documentation that shows the stated gender is sincerely held and part of the person's core identity. (US Soccer Policy)
4. Playing Up
  - a. Requests to play up need to be submitted by April 30<sup>th</sup> to the Board.
  - b. If playing up requests reduce specific team below FAS minimum, players are not allowed to play up.
  - c. If no gender specific age appropriate team available, request to play up to next age then gender specific team is automatic.
5. Tryouts
  - a. All Full Travel Teams are open to tryouts and no player who played on the team the previous seasonal year is guaranteed a roster spot. (By-Law)
  - b. Tryouts are required if number of players is trying out is greater than team CTC minimum and if the Head Coach is only carrying the CTC minimum.
  - c. Players must attend at least 1 tryout or provide Board with valid reason for missing tryouts. (By-Law).
  - d. If numbers permit, players will be separated through independent tryouts into A/B squads.
  - e. The Board will act as Team Head Coach for teams requiring tryouts until independent tryouts are completed.
  - f. Board sets minimum of 2 and maximum of 3 tryout dates between 1 May and 15 June (By-Law).
  - g. Any player not selected to a Full Travel Team will be contacted verbally by the Head Coach within one week of the last tryout date set by PSA and offered a chance to participate in the Recreational Program if the age appropriate bracket is offered (By-Law).

## 6. Coaches

- a. Individuals requesting to be a Head Coach or Assistant Coach of a Full Travel Team must submit their request in writing to the Club/League Representative and Board prior to the general membership meeting before tryouts. (By-Law)
- b. The Board will select Head Coaches with consideration given to; the experience of the coach with soccer, the experience of the coach with the requested team, the experience of the coach within PSA, certifications and recommendations, but these considerations do not automatically determine the selection. (By-Law)
- c. Coaches will follow US Soccer Guidelines on minimum playing time (average 50% per match for U9 to U12).
- d. Teams will be required to have a representative (head/assistant coach or parent) attend at least 3 General Meetings during the Season. (Fall Season is August through December). Failure to attend General Meetings may result in a loss of coaching privileges or playing privileges at the game fields as determined by the Board.
- e. Fines assigned to PSA by affiliated organizations for misconduct, inappropriate behavior or other violations by any coach or parent associated with PSA will reviewed by the Board. Multiple infractions may result in the Board requesting PSA be reimbursed by the individual. Failure to provide reimbursement may result in a loss of coaching privileges or playing privileges at the game fields as determined by the Board.
